I am requesting funding for the Police Department Advanced In-Car Camera System Project for Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Fountain Valley, located at 10200 Slater Ave., Fountain Valley, CA 92708.

The funding would be used to equip the Fountain Valley Police Department's vehicle fleet with an advanced in-car video system.
