I am requesting funding for the **City of Fullerton Local Street Rehabilitation Project** in Fiscal Year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the **City of Fullerton**, located at **303 W. Commonwealth Ave, Fullerton, CA 92832**.

The funding would be used to rehabilitate the deteriorated roadway pavement, repair damaged sidewalk, construct accessible curb ramps, and address roadway drainage within a residential neighborhood in the North-Easterly area of the City. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the project would help the City reconstruct serious and failed streets in the community. As a small City, Fullerton allocations for local road improvement dollars are small, and that funding alone does not provide enough resources to address infrastructure needs. Funding for this project would allow the City to address the streets that are in the worst conditions. This project would help improve the overall quality of life for Fullerton residents, and improve road safety for those that travel through the City.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 23 USC 133, the Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG) Program.
